

Following the Announcement No. 1143 on the Granting of E-commerce Permits or Licenses dated 26 May 2021, on 15 September 2021 the Ministry of Commerce (the "MOC") issued another Announcement No. 2194 on the Granting of E-commerce Permit or License to remind sole proprietors, legal entities and foreign branches (each a "Relevant Person"), who is conducting E-commerce business activities, to apply for an E-Commerce permit or license at the MOC before 1 December 2021.

From 1 December 2021 any Relevant Person that has been operating E-commerce business activities without an E-commerce permit or license is subject to be fined an amount of KHR10,000,000 (equivalent to US\$2,500) or ordered to cease its business activities or face other measures provided for by applicable laws and regulations.

The applications, conditions, requirements and procedures are available at www.ecommercelicensing.moc.gov.kh or the MOC's website www.moc.gov.kh. Also, each applicant can submit his/her application directly either at the Department of Business Registration, General Department of Trade Services of the MOC or via the website www.ecommercelicensing.moc.gov.kh.
